Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.07(5) Requires That Prior to Assignment to Children or Task, the Provider and All Employees (I.e., Volunteers, Students-in-Training, Independent Contractors, Etc.) and Provisional Employees Must Receive Initial Program Orientation. It Was Determined Based on a Review of Records That the Provider Did Not Have Documentation of Initial Orientation of File as Required. (3), 290-2-3-.08(1) Requires the Home to Have a Current and Updated Record for Each Child in Care and for a Period of One (1) Year After Each Child Leaves. Such Records Shall Include: Identifying Information (Child's Name, Birth Date, Parent's Name, Home and Business Addresses, Telephone Numbers) (1), and 290-2-3-.11(2)(c) Requires That Documentation of Drills Required by These Rules Shall Be Maintained in the Home.
