Across 5 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation, a Purse Was Located on the Counter in the Third Right Classroom with Potential Hazardous Items Inside, Accessible to Children in Care. (2), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.11(2) Requires That Personnel Not: Physically or Sexually Abuse a Child or Engage or Permit Others to Engage in Sexually Overt Conduct in the Presence of Any Child Enrolled in the Center (1), and 591-1-1-.26(8) Requires Climbing and Swinging Equipment to Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment Must Be Adequately Maintained by the Center to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined Based on Observation, There Was Less Than 1 Inch of Resilient Surface Measured Under the Slide and Under Fall Zones on the Preschool/SA Playground. (1).
