Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.32(2) Requires the Center Maintain Staff:child Ratios in Mixed-age Groups Based on the Age of the Youngest Group of Children That Includes More Than Twenty Percent of the Total Number of Children in the Mixed- Age Group. It Was Determined Based on Observation That When the Consultant Arrived and for an Additional 15 Minutes, One Staff Member Was Observed Present in Classroom C Caring For (2), 591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Three Posts, Two Near the Building and One on the Back Left Side of the Shade Structure, Had Exposed Concrete That Posed a Potential Hazard.
