It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazards Were Accessible to Children in Care: * Room A-1L- A Roll of Clear Plastic Bags, Destin Maximum Strength Paste (1), 591-1-1-.12 - Equipment and Furniture Observed to Be Properly Secured, as Applicable.
