Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (2), 591-1-1-.32(3) Requires a Center with a Licensed Capacity of 18 or Fewer Children to Maintain Staff-child Ratios in Mixed-age Groups of Children Under Three Years Old Based on the Age of the Youngest Child Under Three Years of Age. Where All of the Children in Any One Group Are Three Years of Age or Older, the Age of the Majority of the Children in the Group Shall Determine the Staff: Child Ratios (2), and Center Menu Meets USDA Guidelines. Finding 591-1-1-.15(2) Requires That a Signed Written Feeding Plan for Children Less Than One (1) Year of Age Shall Be Obtained From Parent(s) and That Instructions From the Parent(s) Shall Be Updated Regularly as New Foods Are Added or Other Dietary Changes Are Made.
