(2), 591-1-1-.15(2) Requires That a Signed Written Feeding Plan for Children Less Than One (1) Year of Age Shall Be Obtained From Parent(s) and That Instructions From the Parent(s) Shall Be Updated Regularly as New Foods Are Added or Other Dietary Changes Are Made. The Feeding Plan Shall Be Posted in the Child's Assigned Room and Must Include the Child's Feeding Schedule, the Amount of Formula or Breas (1), and 591-1-1-.36(4)(a) Requires an Annual Safety Check for Each Vehicle. The Annual Safety Check, Completed by a Trained Individual, Should Include a Check of The: Tires, Headlights, Horn, Taillights, Turn Signals, Brake Lights, Brakes, Suspension, Exhaust System, Steering, Windows, Windshields and Windshield Wipers. A Copy of the Annual Safety Check Will Be Kept in the Center or on the Vehicle and Sho (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
