A Center May Accept a Satisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination Letter or a Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination Letter Issue (2), Please Ensure That Bottles Are Covered and Fully Labeled with Child's Full Name. Finding 591-1-1-.15(2) Requires That a Signed Written Feeding Plan for Children Less Than One (1) Year of Age Shall Be Obtained From Parent(s) and That Instructions From the Parent(s) Shall Be Updated Regularly as New Foods Are Added or Other Dietary Changes Are Made.
