Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.03(8) Requires a Center to Provide Individual Attention to Each Child by Responding Promptly to the Child's Distress Signals and Need for Comfort. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Upon Arrival to the 1st Left Classroom and an Infant Was on the Floor Crying. The Staff Member in the Class Was Getting Kids Out of Chairs and Handwashing, and Verbally Tried to Console the Child. Ano (1), 591-1-1-.06(7) Requires Center Staff to Ensure Bathrooms Are Cleaned Daily with a Disinfectant. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Bathrooms Throughout Were Not Being Cleaned Daily in the the Bottom Rims of the Toilets Had Dust and Particles. It Was Further Determined That in the 4th Left Classroom Toilet Paper with a Brown Residue Was Left Behind the Toilet. (1), and Please Be Mindful to Keep Items That Pose a Hazard Inaccessible to Children. Finding 591-1-1-.25(3) Requires the Center and Surrounding Premises to Be Kept Clean, Free of Debris and in Good Repair. Hygienic Measures Such As, but Not Limited To, Screened Windows and Proper Waste Disposal Procedures Shall Be Utilized to Minimize the Presence of Rodents, Flies, Roaches and Other Vermin at the Center.
