Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Classroom A Had a Total of 14 Children Present When the Classroom Has a License Capacity of Six (6). (1), 591-1-1-.25(11) Requires That Floor Coverings Be Tight, Smooth, Free of Odors and Washable or Cleanable. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Flooring in the First Bathroom in Classroom C When You Enter the Classroom, What Not Tight. The Linoleum Was Rolled Up and Not Attached to the Wall with the Baseboard Around the Toilet. (1), and 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department.
