Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-17(7) Requires That Children Wash Their Hands with Liquid Soap and Warm Running Water Upon Arrival for Care, When Moving From One Child Care Group to Another, Upon Re-entering the Child Care Area After Outside Play, Before and After Eating Meals and Snacks, Handling or Touching Food, Playing in Water (2), 591-1-1-.07(5) Requires Center Staff to Not Permit Children to Wear Around Their Necks or Attach to Their Clothing Pacifiers or Other Hazardous Items. It Was Determined Based on Observation That an Infant in Room 1L Was Asleep in the Crib to the Right of the Door with a Bib Attached Around Their Neck. (1), and 591-1-1-.15(3) Requires Baby Bottles and Formula to Be Labeled with the Individual Child's Name (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
