Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.07(8)(b) Requires the Provider, a Provisional Employee or Employee with Current Evidence of Successful Completion of Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Pediatric First Aid Must Always Be on the Home's Premises Whenever Any Child Is Present. It Was Determined Based on Review of Records That Staff #1 (Hire Date August 15, 2006) Did Not Have Evidence of Current Pediatric Card (2), 290-2-3-.11(2)(c) Requires That Documentation of Drills Required by These Rules Shall Be Maintained in the Home. The Home Shall Conduct Drills for Fire, Tornado, and Other Emergency Situations. The Fire Drills Will Be Conducted Monthly and Tornado and Other Emergency Situation Drills Will Be Conducted Every Six Months. The Home Shall Maintain Documentation of the Dates and Times of These Drills Fo (1), and 290-2-3-.13(2)(a) Requires That Outdoor Play Areas Be Kept Clean and Free of Hazards Such as Exposed Sharp Corners of Concrete or Equipment, Rust and Splinters on Equipment, Broken Glass, Open Drainage Ditches, Holes and Stagnant Water. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Hazards Were Observed on the Outdoor Play Area When Several Pieces of Vinyl Siding Were Observed on the Ground and Had (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
