It Was Determined Based on Review and Statement Upon Consultant's Arrival at the Home There Was No Employee in the Home's Premises With (4) and 290-2-3-.04(1)(d) Requires a Person That Provides Care for More Than Six Children for Pay, Related or Unrelated, as Defined in These Rules, Shall Make Application to the Department for a License to Operate a Child Care Learning Center, Except as Provided in 290-2-3-.07(15).
