Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.11(2)(f) Requires That Poisons, Medicines, Cleaning Agents and Other Hazardous Materials Be in Locked Areas or Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Lotion and a Container of Hand Sanitizer Were Stored on a Shelf and Accessible to Children in the Front Play Area (2), 290-2-3-.13(2)(a) Requires That Outdoor Play Areas Be Kept Clean and Free of Hazards Such as Exposed Sharp Corners of Concrete or Equipment, Rust and Splinters on Equipment, Broken Glass, Open Drainage Ditches, Holes and Stagnant Water. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Was a Container of Plant Food on a Shelf Near the Front of the Outdoor Play Area That Was Accessible to Children. (2), and 290-2-3-.08(1) Requires the Home to Have a Current and Updated Record for Each Child in Care and for a Period of One (1) Year After Each Child Leaves. Such Records Shall Include: Identifying Information (Child's Name, Birth Date, Parent's Name, Home and Business Addresses, Telephone Numbers) (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
