Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the License Capacity of Room Main A5-Middle Right Rm (1's) Two Year Olds Was Exceeded, as the Room Was Approved for Nine Children and Ten Children Were Present. Additionally, the License Capacity of Room Main A-3(back (2), 591-1-1-.09(1)(c) Requires the Center to Ensure That Every Employee Has a Valid and Current Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on File Prior to Being Present at the Center While Any Child Is Present for Care or Before an Individual Age 17 or Older Resides in the Center. The Comprehensive Records Check Determination Must Have a Records Check Clearance Date That Is No Older Than (1), and 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members Are Physically Present in T (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
