Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.03(6) Requires Center Staff to Ensure Children Less Than Three Years of Age Do Not Spend More Than One-half Hour of Time Consecutively in Confining Equipment, Such as Swings, Highchairs, Jump Seats, Carriers or Walkers. Children Shall Use Such Equipment Only When They Are Awake. Such Children Shall Be Allowed Time to Play on the Floor Daily. Infants Shall Have Su (1), and Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.15(2)(a) Requires Center Personnel to Hold and Feed Infants Less Than Six Months of Age and Older Children Who Cannot Hold Their Own Bottles or Sit Alone. Baby Bottles Shall Never Be Propped (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
