Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.13(2)(a) Requires That Outdoor Play Areas Be Kept Clean and Free of Hazards Such as Exposed Sharp Corners of Concrete or Equipment, Rust and Splinters on Equipment, Broken Glass, Open Drainage Ditches, Holes and Stagnant Water. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Wooden Barrier to the Mulch Area Had Two Boards That Were Warped and Weathered and Posed a Splinter and Trip Hazard (3), 290-2-3-.08(2) Requires the Home to Maintain a File for Each Child That Includes Evidence of Age-appropriate Immunizations or a Signed Affidavit Against Such Immunizations (1), and 290-2-3-.07(8)(b) Requires the Provider, a Provisional Employee or Employee with Current Evidence of Successful Completion of Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Pediatric First Aid Must Always Be on the Home's Premises Whenever Any Child Is Present.
