Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Director Provided Six Files for Employees Hired Since Last Visit January 8, 2026. Finding 591-1-1-.09(i) Requires That for a Provisional Employee to Become a Permanent Employee, the Individual Must Have a Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination. It Was Determined Based on Review of Records That the Center Did Not Submit a Portability Request for Staff #18's, Date of Hire Unknown, Sat (1), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1), and 591-1-1-17(7) Requires That Children Wash Their Hands with Liquid Soap and Warm Running Water Upon Arrival for Care, When Moving From One Child Care Group to Another, Upon Re-entering the Child Care Area After Outside Play, Before and After Eating Meals and Snacks, Handling or Touching Food, Playing in Water (1).
