Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.08(1) Requires the Home to Have a Current and Updated Record for Each Child in Care and for a Period of One (1) Year After Each Child Leaves. Such Records Shall Include: Identifying Information (Child's Name, Birth Date, Parent's Name, Home and Business Addresses, Telephone Numbers) (2), 290-2-3-.12(6) Requires All Indoor and Outdoor Furniture, Activity Materials, and Equipment Shall Be Placed So as to Permit the Children's Freedom of Movement and to Minimize Danger of Accident or Collision. It Was Determined Upon Arrival Red and Yellow Chairs Were Stacked on Top of a White Open Shelf, Blue Cots Were Leaned Up Against the Wall, and a Red Table Was in a Upward Position with the Fou (1), and 290-2-3-.11(2)(c) Requires That Documentation of Drills Required by These Rules Shall Be Maintained in the Home.
