Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Consultant Discussed with the Director That Bright From the Start Required the Director and the Person with Primary Responsibility for Food Preparation to Complete Four Clock Hours of Training in Food Nutrition Planning, Preparation, Serving, Proper Dish Washing and Food Storage Within the First Year of Employment. (2), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members A (1), and 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in Room D There Was a Staff Member's Purse Observed to Be Stored on the Floor and Was in Reach of Children.
