Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(8) Requires Climbing and Swinging Equipment to Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment Must Be Adequately Maintained by the Center to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined That All Playgrounds Lacked Adequate Resilient Surface. (2). None of the 2 findings were critical.

- **591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Consultant Observation the Wooden Border on the Far Left Playground Was Observed to Have Six Protruding Nails Potentially Hazardous to Children in Care on This Date.**
