Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.11(2) Requires That Personnel Not: Physically or Sexually Abuse a Child or Engage or Permit Others to Engage in Sexually Overt Conduct in the Presence of Any Child Enrolled in the Center (1), Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.31(13) Prohibits Center Staff From Committing Any Criminal Act, as Defined Under Georgia Law, in the Presence of Any Child Enrolled in the Center and Requires Center Staff to Comply with All Applicable Laws and Regulations. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That on July 28, 2025, a Staff Member in Classroom G Instructed a 9-year-old Child and a 4-ye (1), and Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Membe (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

It Was Determined Based on Observation That Two 2-year-old Children and Five 1-year-old Children Were Served Slices of Peaches That Were Not Cut Into One-half Inch or Smaller Pieces**
