Comment Trees Located on the Site or That Encroach Onto the Site From Adjacent Properties May Have Structural Issues That Present an Elevated Level of Risk. Consider Having These Trees Inspected by a Certified Arborist to Determine Their Structural Integrity and Associated Levels of Risk.
