Such Records Shall Include: Identifying Information (Child's Name, Birth Date, Parent's Name, Home and Business Addresses, Telephone Numbers) (4) and 290-2-3-.11(2)(a) Requires the Home to Have a Written Plan for Handling Emergencies, Including but Not Limited to Fire, Severe Weather, Loss of Electrical Power or Water, and Death, Serious Injury or Loss of a Child, a Threatening Event, or Natural Disaster Which May Occur at the Home.
