Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.36(4)(b) Requires That the Interior of a Transportation Vehicle Be Clean, in Safe Repair and Free of Hazardous Items, Objects And/or Other Non-essential Items Which Could Cause Injury. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazards Were Identified on the Transportation Vehicles: • White Van (Tag #CSU9149): Holes Were Observed Near the Bottom of the Seats Facing the Aisl (3), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity. It Was Determined by Review of Records on July 24, 2025, the Facility Failed to Maintain Its License Capacity of 22 Children When 29 Children Were Present. (1), and 591-1-1-.30(2)(c) Requires That Infants Shall Not Sleep in Equipment Other Than Safety-approved Cribs, Such As, but Not Limited To, a Car Safety Seat, Bouncy Seat, Highchair, or Swing.
