The Schedule Must Be Posted in Each Group's Room or Area and Made Available to Parent(s) Upon Request. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Classroom Schedules Were Not Posted in Classrooms on This Date. (1), 591-1-1-.25(3) Requires the Center and Surrounding Premises to Be Kept Clean, Free of Debris and in Good Repair.
