For Example, Toddlers Shall Not Be Permitted to Swing in Swings Designed for School-age Children. The Outdoor Equipment Shall Be Free of Lead-based Paint, Sharp Corners and Shall Be Regularly Maintained in Such a Way as to Be Free of Rust And (2), Paperwork, Checklist, Permission Forms, Annual Inspection Form and Proper Check of the Vehicle After Transportation Were Discussed with the Director.
