Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.36(7)(d)2. Requires That the Second Designated Staff Person Conduct a Check of the Vehicle Immediately Upon the Completion of the First Check of the Vehicle. The Responsible Person Shall Physically Walk Through the Entire Vehicle (1), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.29(1) Requires That Within Twenty-four (24) Hours or the Next Work Day, the Director or Designated Person-in-charge Shall Report or Cause to Be Reported Any Suspected Incidents of Child Abuse, Neglect or Deprivation to the Local County Division of Family and Children Services in Accordance with State Law and to the Department, Notifying That Such a Report Was Mad (1), and 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members Are Physically Present in T (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
