Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.12(1) Requires Each Employee and Child in Attendance to Use All Indoor and Outdoor Furniture, Activity Materials, and Equipment in a Safe and Appropriate Manner and in Accordance with the Manufacturer's Instructions, Recommendations, and Intended Use. All Equipment and Furniture Shall Be Used Only by the Age- Appropriate Group of Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There (1), 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members Are Physically Present in T (1), and 591-1-1-.08(1) Requires the Center Staff to Maintain a File for Each Child While Such Child Is in Care and for One Year After That Child Is No Longer Enrolled.
