Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.09(1)(a) Requires That a Center Ensure That Every Actual and Potential Director, Employee and Provisional Employee of a Child Care Learning Center Submit Both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an Authorized Fingerprinting Site. It Was Determined Based on a Review of Records That Staff #6 with a Date of Hire of August 4, 2025, Did Not Submit Both a Records C (1), 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Were 29 Children Present in the Main B:3L Classroom Which Had a Limited License Capacity of 24 Children. (1), and 591-1-1-.15(7) Requires That Food Be Served According to Manufacturer's Instructions and Recommendations. Foods That Are Associated with Young Children's Choking Incidents, Such As, but Not Limited To, Peanuts, Hot Dogs, Raw Carrots, Popcorn, Fish with Bones, Cheese Cubes, Grapes and Any Other Food That Is of Similar Shape and Size of the Trachea/windpipe Shall Not Be Served to the Children Less T (1).
