Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.11(2) Requires That Personnel Not: Physically or Sexually Abuse a Child or Engage or Permit Others to Engage in Sexually Overt Conduct in the Presence of Any Child Enrolled in the Center (1), Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.31(13) Prohibits Center Staff From Committing Any Criminal Act, as Defined Under Georgia Law, in the Presence of Any Child Enrolled in the Center and Requires Center Staff to Comply with All Applicable Laws and Regulations. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That on October 23, 2025 and on October 30, 2025, a Staff Member Hit a Child on the Arm as A (1), and 591-1-1-.03(1) Requires the Center to Provide a Daily Planned Program of Varied and Developmentally Appropriate Activities to Promote Social, Emotional, Physical, Cognitive, Language and Literacy Growth. Center Staff Shall Use a Variety of Teaching Methods to Accommodate the Needs of the Children's Different Learning Styles. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Were No Lesson Plans Av (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
