Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(6) Requires That Playground Equipment Provide an Opportunity for the Children to Engage in a Variety of Experiences and Shall Be Age-appropriate. For Example, Toddlers Shall Not Be Permitted to Swing in Swings Designed for School-age Children. The Outdoor Equipment Shall Be Free of Lead-based Paint, Sharp Corners and Shall Be Regularly Maintained in Such a Way as to Be Free of Rust And (2), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children.
