Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.06(1) Requires the Center to Provide a Specified Minimum Number of Flush Toilets and Hand Washing Sinks with Running Water for the Use of All Children, at Least One Flush Toilet for Children Being Potty-trained and to Not Substitute Nursery Potty Chairs for a Required Flush Toilet. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Toilet in the Boy's Bathroom Did Not Flush Causing the Toile (1), 591-1-1-.30(1)(a)3 Requires That Each Crib Shall Have Only an Individual, Tight-fitting Sheet Which Is Changed Daily or More Often as Needed and Prior to a Change of Occupant. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Three Out of Three Crib Sheets Were Loose and Not Tight Fitting as Required in the First Left Classroom. (1), and 591-1-1-.14(1)(a) Requires All Staff Who Provide Direct Care to Children Must Obtain Certification in a Biennial Training Program in Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and a Triennial Training Program in Pediatric First Aid Within the First 45 Days of Employment. Current and Valid Evidence of the Successful Completion of Such Training Shall Be Maintained on the Center's Premises. The Ho (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
