Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-17(7) Requires That Children Wash Their Hands with Liquid Soap and Warm Running Water Upon Arrival for Care, When Moving From One Child Care Group to Another, Upon Reentering the Child Care Area After Outside Play, Before and After Eating Meals and Snacks, Handling or Touching Food, Playing in Water (2), Please Replace/add Missing/expired Item(s) in First Aid Kit(s). Finding 591-1-1-.14(1) Requires the Center Director And, at Any Given Time, at Least Fifty Percent (50%) of the Caregiver Staff to Successfully Complete a Biennial Training Program in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and a Triennial Training Program in First Aid. The First Aid Training Must Be Done by Certified or Licensed Health C (1), and Please Secure Cleaning Tools (I.e., Broom, Plunger) Out of Reach of Children. Finding 591-1-1-.25(17) Requires That the Center Premises Be Free of Plants and Shrubs Which Are Poisonous or Hazardous. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Two Pothos Plants Were Observed in Classroom D. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

It Was Determined Based Upon Observation That Six Out of Seven Children Were Missing a Light Cover in the B-Middle Right Classroom.**
