Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Membe (2), 591-1-1-.09(1)(c) Requires the Center to Ensure That Every Employee Has a Valid and Current Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on File Prior to Being Present at the Center While Any Child Is Present for Care or Before an Individual Age 17 or Older Resides in the Center. The Comprehensive Records Check Determination Must Have a Records Check Clearance Date That Is No Older Than (1), and 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Classrooms Had Hazardous Items Accessible to Children in Care: F- Baby Wipes Were in the Cubbies. G- Adult Scissors, Stapler, Staples, Tape Dispenser and Adhesive Magnetic Dots Were in an Unlocked Green (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
