Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Observation That on Main Right Older Playground the White Fence Separating Main Middle Toddler Playground From Main Right Older Playground Had a Missing Panel That Created a 9 Inch Gap Tha (1), Discussed SIDS and Infant Sleeping Position.
