Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Discussed Movement of Children to Maintain Capacities. Finding 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity. It Was Determined Based on Observations That the Entrance 3-4 Yrs Room Had Eight Children Present with a Licensed Capacity of 5 Children as Required. (2), 591-1-1-.32(5) Requires That During Day-time Rest or Sleeping Periods, at Least One Staff Person Is in Each Room Providing Direct Supervision of the Children and All Staff Required by These Rules Relating to Staff: Child Ratios Are in the Center and Available to Assure Safe Evacuation in an Emergency. Staff: Child Ratios May Be Doubled for Children Three (3) Years and Older Provided These Requirem (2), and 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observations That the Following Hazards Were Accessible to Children: Room 1R -Mosquito and Tick Repellent -Desitin Cream -Aquaphor Cream -Baby Wipes Room Entrance 3-4 -Permanent Marker -Disinfectant Spray (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
