Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(11) Requires That Floor Coverings Be Tight, Smooth, Free of Odors and Washable or Cleanable. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Following Sections of the Flooring Had Soft Areas and Were Not Stable: -Room Main A in Front of the Gate Leading to the Back Area -Room Main C in Front of the Sink Area The Director Stated That Repairs Had Began and Paperwork Was Provided Showing an E (2), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (2), and 591-1-1-.14(2)(b) Requires That There Must Always Be One Staff Person Present in Each Classroom Where Children Are Present That Has Current and Valid Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Pediatric First Aid Training. It Was Determined Based on Observation and Review of Records, Staff Number Two Was Present and Cared for Children Alone in Main Room C and Staff Member Number One Was Pre (1).
