Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.09(3) Requires That Outdoor Activities Be Provided Daily, Weather Permitting. It Was Determined Based on Staff Interviews That Outdoor Activities Had Not Been Provided for Children in Care. (1), Discussed SIDS and Infant Sleeping Position. Finding 290-2-3-.19(1)(a)3 Requires That Each Crib and Other Equipment Approved for Infant Sleep Shall Have Only an Individual, Tight-fitting Sheet Which Is Changed Daily or More Often as Needed and Prior to a Change of Occupant. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Two of Four Playard Sheets Were Not Tight-fitting on This Date. (1), and 290-2-3-.08(1) Requires the Home to Have a Current and Updated Record for Each Child in Care and for a Period of One (1) Year After Each Child Leaves.
