Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.09(1)(e) Requires That No Actual or Potential Director, Employee or Provisional Employee of a Child Care Learning Center with an Unsatisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination or an Unsatisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination May Be Present at a Center When Any Child Is Present for Care or Reside at a Center. It Was Determined Based on Observation and a Review of Reco (1), 591-1-1-.26(6) Requires That Playground Equipment Provide an Opportunity for the Children to Engage in a Variety of Experiences and Shall Be Age-appropriate. For Example, Toddlers Shall Not Be Permitted to Swing in Swings Designed for School-age Children.
