Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.29(1) Requires That Within Twenty-four (24) Hours or the Next Work Day, the Director or Designated Person-in-charge Shall Report or Cause to Be Reported Any Suspected Incidents of Child Abuse, Neglect or Deprivation to the Local County Division of Family and Children Services in Accordance with State Law and to the Department, Notifying That Such a Report Was Mad (1), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.11(2) Requires That Personnel Not: Physically or Sexually Abuse a Child or Engage or Permit Others to Engage in Sexually Overt Conduct in the Presence of Any Child Enrolled in the Center (1), and 591-1-1-.08(1) Requires the Center Staff to Maintain a File for Each Child While Such Child Is in Care and for One Year After That Child Is No Longer Enrolled.
