Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.09(1)(a) Requires That a Center Ensure That Every Actual and Potential Director, Employee and Provisional Employee of a Child Care Learning Center Submit Both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an Authorized Fingerprinting Site. It Was Determined Based on a Review of Records That Staff Members #3, #5, #8, #11, and #12 That Were Present at the Facility in Roo (1), The Consultant Discussed with the Provider That the Floor in the Three Year Old Room Had a Few Strips Lifting and Torn Right Before the Sink Area and That All Floors Must Be Tight, Smooth, Free of Odors and Washable or Cleanable. (1), and 591-1-1-.26(3) Requires That the Playground Be Adjacent to the Center or in an Area Which Can Be Reached by a Safe Route or Method Approved by the Department. Except in School-age Centers, the Playground Shall Have Shaded Areas. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Route to the Playground Went Through the Three Year Old Class. (1).
