Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.11(1)(e) Requires the Home and Any Vehicle Used for Transportation Children to Have a First Aid Kit Which at Least Contains: Scissors, Tweezers, Gauze Pads, Thermometer, Adhesive Tape, Band-aids, Insect - Sting Preparation, Antiseptic Cleaning Solution, Antibacterial Ointment, Bandages, Disposable Rubber Gloves, Protective Eyewear, Facemask, and Cold Pack. The First Aid Kit, Together With (2), 290-2-3-.13(2)(c) Requires That Climbing and Swinging Equipment That Are Not Portable Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment, Which Is Adequately Maintained by the Home to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined Based on Observation There Was No Resilient Surface in the Fall Zone of the Three Feet Teeter-totter. The Equipment Was on a Grassy Su (1), and 290-2-3-.12(1) Requires the Home to Provide a Variety of Age-appropriate Toys, Books and Play Equipment and Materials. It Was Determined Based on Observation, the Provider Lacked Toys and Equipment for a Science Center. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
