Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.11(1)(j) Requires Children's Hands to Be Washed with Liquid Soap and Warm Running Water: Immediately Upon Arrival for the Day and Re-entering the Child Care Area After Outside Play (2), 290-2-3-.09(5) Requires That Children Less Than Three (3) Years of Age Shall Not Spend More Than One-half (1/2) Hour of Time Consecutively in Confining Equipment, Such as Swings, Highchairs, Jumpseats, Carriers or Walkers. Children Shall Use Such Equipment Only When They Are Awake. Such Children Shall Be Allowed Time to Play on the Floor Daily. It Was Determined Based Observation That Two 1-year-o (1), and 290-2-3-.04(1)(d) Requires a Person That Provides Care for More Than Six Children for Pay, Related or Unrelated, as Defined in These Rules, Shall Make Application to the Department for a License to Operate a Child Care Learning Center, Except as Provided in 290-2-3-.07(15). It Was Determined Based on Observation and a Review of Records That 11 Children Were Present in the Home for Pay. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
