Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (2), 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity.
