Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.29(3) Requires the Director or Designated Person-in-charge to Report or Cause to Be Reported to the Department Within Twenty-four (24) Hours or the Next Work Day: Any Death of a Child While in the Care of the Center (1), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Nap Time, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members (1), and 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Classroom 9I Was Over Capacity by One Child. The Maximum Capacity Is 20 and There Were 21 Children Present. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
