Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Lysol Wipes Were Observed on Top of the Table on the Right Side Accessible to Children in Care. It Was Further Determined That a Large Bottle of Sanitizer Was Observed on the Cart on the Right Side of the Table Access (1), 591-1-1-.33(2)(a)-(n) - Discussed That All Employees, Including Volunteers, Independent Contractors, Students-in- Training, Etc. Should Have a Completed Initial Program Orientation Form on File. (1), and 591-1-1-.09(1)(j) Requires That for Portability for Directors, Employees and Provisional Employees, Excluding Students-in-Training, Only the Most Recently Issued Determination Letter Is Eligible for Portability and Must Be Ported Electronically. A Center May Accept a Satisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination Letter or a Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination Letter Issue (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
