Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1), CACFP Meal Pattern Requirements Effective October 1, 2017 Will Be Implemented October 1, 2018: 3 Components for Breakfast: Grains, Vegetables, Fruits or Both, Milk 5 Components for Lunch – Grains, Meat/Meat Alternates, Fruits, Vegetable, and Milk OR Grains, Meat/Meat Alternates, 2 Different Types of Vegetables, and Milk 2 of 5 Components for Snack Provided Updated CACFP Infant Meal Pattern and Chi (1), and 591-1-1-.07(5) Requires Center Staff to Not Permit Children to Wear Around Their Necks or Attach to Their Clothing Pacifiers or Other Hazardous Items.
