Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.07(7)(a)-(j) Requires That the Provider, Employees and Provisional Employees with Direct Care Responsibilities Shall Complete Health and Safety Orientation Training Within the First 90 Days of Employment. The State-approved Training Hours Obtained Will Count Toward Required First Year Training Hours. The Training Must Address the Following Health and Safety Topics: (A) Prevention and Cont (2), 290-2-3-.12(5) Requires All Indoor and Outdoor Furniture, Activity Materials, and Equipment Shall Be Free From Hazardous Conditions Such As, but Not Limited To, Sharp Rough Edges or Toxic Paint and Kept Clean. It Was Determined Based on Observation That a Television on a Shelf Was Not Tightly Secured and Accessible to Children. (1), and 290-2-3-.19(1)(b) Requires That Cots and Mats Shall Be Provided for Each Child Who Is Two (2) Years of Age or Older and Who Is Required to Take a Nap and for Each Child Under the Age of Two Years Who Can Climb Out of a Crib or Other Equipment Approved for Infant Sleep.
