Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Observation That There Was Landscaping Fabric Exposed on the Right Playground Creating a Potential Tripping Hazard. (1), Staff Stated Knowledge of Infant Safe Sleep Requirements. Finding 591-1-1-.30(1)(b)3 Requires That Sheets or Similar Coverings for Cots or Mats Shall Either Be Marked for Individual Use or Laundered Daily. If Marked for Individual Use, They Must Be Laundered Weekly or More Frequently if Needed.
