Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.12(8) Requires Toys for Children Under Three Years of Age to Be Age-appropriate (1), 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity. It Was Determined Based on Observation and Child Head Count That Two Staff and Twenty-one Children the Ages of Five and Above Were Located in Classroom B Which Is Licensed for Fourteen Children. (1), and 591-1-1-.25(11) Requires That Floor Coverings Be Tight, Smooth, Free of Odors and Washable or Cleanable. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Classroom B Had a One Inch by Two Inch Rip in the Linoleum Near the Table Located in Front of the Large Mirror.
